What is a developmental disability?

PDD has **three** key areas for the determination of a developmental disability, **all** of which must be met:

1. Significant limitations in at least two adaptive life skills such as communication, self-care, home living, community use, self-direction, health and safety, functional academics, leisure and work.
2. Significantly below average intellectual ability.
3. Onset prior to age 18.
